Football takes 3rd straight; hosts Fullerton on Saturday

Just one week after posting victory 100 coach Frank Mazzotta and the Falcon football team rolled into Riverside looking to remain undefeated (3-0), and to avenge last year's Simple Green Bowl loss.

Led by Corey Kelley's 61 yard TD run and a one-yard TD run, plus a 17 yard TD run and a one yard TD run by Charles Ephriam, Cerritos cruised to a impressive 35-20 road win.

In a game that was dominated by the run, quarterback Gary Tessitore tossed a 13 yard touchdown to Gabe Anguiano.

After two consecutive road wins the Falcons return home on Saturday to tangle with Fullerton.

IN VOLLEYBALL, behind the impressive play of Paula Makridis and Colleen Jewell Cerritos' team swept through the competition and into the semi-finals.

The Falcons (3-0), flew past King's River 15-4, 15-5, Grossmont 16-14, 15-4, Bakersfield 15-4, 15-6, and Eastern Arizona 15-6, 17-15.

Cerritos' domination of the pool play positioned them as the play-offs number one seed.

In the semi-finals Yavapai Arizona, got the better of the Falcons as they defeated Cerritos 15-13, 15-12.

With the completion of the San Diego Mesa tournament the Volleyballers will host an alumni match Friday October 7.

THE STATE CHAMPION WRESTLERS hosted and won their own tournament as they defeated South Coast Conference champion Rancho Santiago 24-15.

Individual Falcon's of note were Rudolph James who captured the 150 pound title, and Dave Gayer who made to

the final match in the 134 pound division.

The wrestlers return to the mats today as they travel to Victor Valley.


